

Surveyed on the fifth day of July 1793 nine hundred and ninety acres of land with the allowance of six percent situate in District No. 6, in the Late Purchase, on the East side of the Allegany River adjoining Wilhem Willink and others, No. 2681, by virtue of a warrant to Wilhem Willink, Nicolaas Van Staphorst, Christiaan Van Eeghen, Hendrick Vollenhoven, and Rutger Jan Schirmelpenninck of Amsterdam, No. 2682, dated the twelfth day of December 1792.
