



The above is a Draught of a Tract of Land situate on the Waters of Chartes Creek Call-Plantz Containing three hundred and Ninety, ^{Nine} acres and a half Surveyed March the 14th 1786. In pursuance of Certificat-Granted to Eligah Nuttle by Virginia Commissioners in the following words

Recd 8th Feby. 1786.

We the Commissioners for Adjusting Claims to Unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongahalia, Yohogania & Ohio do hereby Certify that Eligah Nuttle is entitled to four hundred Acres of land in the County of Ohio on Chartes Creek to Include his Actual Settlement maid in the year 1776.

Given Under our hands at Coxes fort the 22d of February 1780, in the fourth Year of the Commonwealth
