

The above Draft represents a part of the Bed of the Ohio River. Survayed June 19th A.D. 1848 in pursuance of a warrant granted to John D. Mahon for 100 Acres of the bed of the Ohio River. Dated May 29th 1848, being bounded as above by low water mark. Situate in Beaver County and immediatly above the Mouth of the Beaver River. Containing one hundred acres.
