



Brought of a tract of Land Situate in the Townships of Derry & Marple formerly Cumberland now Mifflin County. Containing Two hundred and Thirteen Acres and 47 perches and the Allowance of Six p^t Cent for roads & this Survey appears began the 25th day of March 1793 by James Harris late Deputy Surveyor $\frac{1}{2}$ and by me finished the 14th day of February 1803. In pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Jeremiah Talbot dated the 2^d day of May 1774.

William Lewis hereby Caveates a Patent being Granted to any person on the above Survey he claiming on An Improvement Title made Sevral years previous to the date of the above Warrant & held in a continued Possession until the present date June 4th 1803.
