

Draft of a Tract of Land situate in St. Thomas Township (formerly Hamilton township) Franklin County containing Fifty two acres One hundred & fifty perches & allowance of Six per Cent for roads &c Located the 19<sup>th</sup> of April 1830 (on a warrant granted Margaret Dixon Widow for 50<sup>as</sup> of land joining Adam Carson & Henry Larken in Hamilton Township dated 6<sup>th</sup> Sept 1753) In pursuance of a Contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several acts of assembly relating to Proprietary rights &c

The land above described is included in a Survey containing 223 1/17 per Gall which was surveyed on a warrant granted William Dixon & Joseph Dixon dated the 17<sup>th</sup> of January 1785 there is no evidence of any survey having been made on the warrant to Margaret Dixon but from information obtained she was the owner of the above land or part thereof and W<sup>m</sup> & Joseph Dixon were children & heirs of the said Margaret.
