

A Draught of an Island situate in the township of Manor in the County of Lancaster Called Rock Island near the York County shore, about half a mile from the mouth of Fishing creek nearly six hundred yards south of Musers & Bears fisheries immediately below Turkey Hill falls, containing forty one perches strict measure, Surveyed in pursuance of a warrant dated 21st day of January Anno Domini 1822, granted to Jacob Eiter,
