

Robt Roberts

Pursuant to a warrant under the hands of the Commiss<sup>ers</sup> of prop-  
erty and the seal of the Prince to David Powel directed bearing  
date the 22<sup>d</sup> of the 10 month 1701 authorizing him to Resurvey  
unto Robert Roberts and Owen Roberts each of them a tract of land  
Reputed to Contain two hundred acres given them by their father  
Hugh Roberts and now Respectively in their possession The said  
David Powel hath Resurvey'd to the Robert Roberts his said tract  
situate in Merion in the County of Philadelphia Beginning at  
an old stump at the Corner of Edward Jones Junior's Land from  
thence west fifteen degrees southerly by the said Jones his  
land and by Edward Rees his land 353 perches to a stake  
from thence by other land of the said Edward Rees and by Rob-  
ert Owen's Land north 18 degrees westerly ninety perches to a  
second stake from thence east 14 degrees and a half norther-  
ly by Thomas Jones and Company's Land 404 perches to a  
third stake from thence by Owen Roberts's Land south 18 de-  
grees easterly 106 perches to a fourth stake from thence by  
Robert Davids Land West 15 degrees southerly 49 perches  
to a fifth stake from thence north ten degrees westerly 23  
perches to the place of beginning. Containing two hundred  
and twenty acres resurvey'd. Revised in the Gen<sup>l</sup> Surveyor's office.
