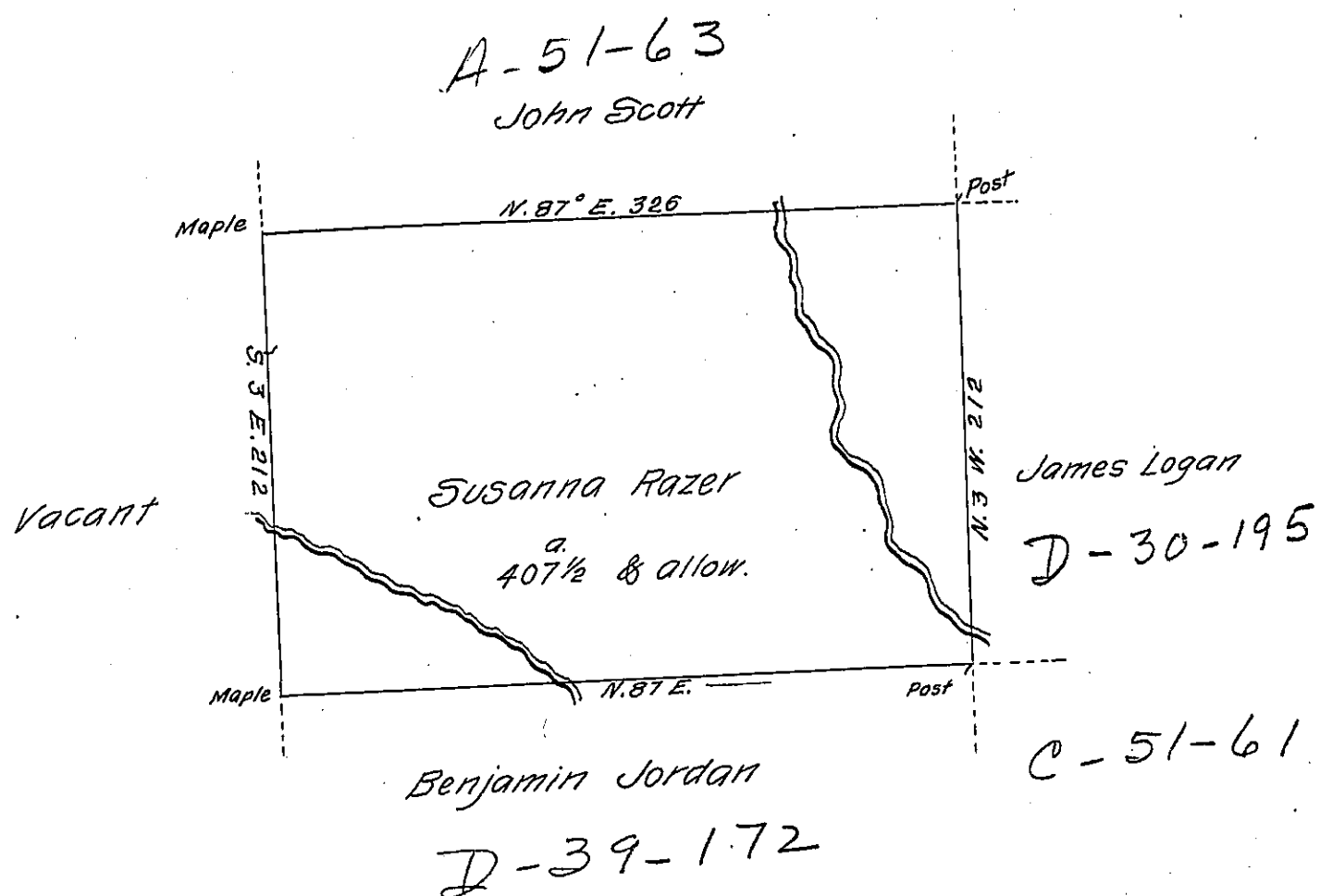




A Draught of a tract of land called ——— situate on the waters of
