



Situate in Frankstown Township, Huntingdon County, Containing One hundred Seventy five acres, twenty seven perches and allowance of Six per Cent for roads &c. and including an improvement. First surveyed in 1799. And resurveyed the 30th day of May 1818. In pursuance of a war^t to Francis Henry, dated the 26th day of May 1798.

The peice marked **A** is claimed by a survey made the 11th July, 1794, in pursuance of a war^t to Jacob Buss dated the 13th Feby. 1794, and the peice marked **B**, is claimed by a survey made the 10th July, 1794, in pursuance of a war^t to Jacob Klader, dated the 13th Feb^y. 1794.
