

 ship, Huntingdon County. Containing Six Acres 78 perches strick measure. Survey-
 ed the 22nd day of April, 1836. In pursuance of a Warrant granted to Jon-
 athan H. Dorsey, for himself, in trust for the other heirs of Greenberry Dorsey, Decs^d.
 Dated the 17th day of Feb^y A.D. 1836.
