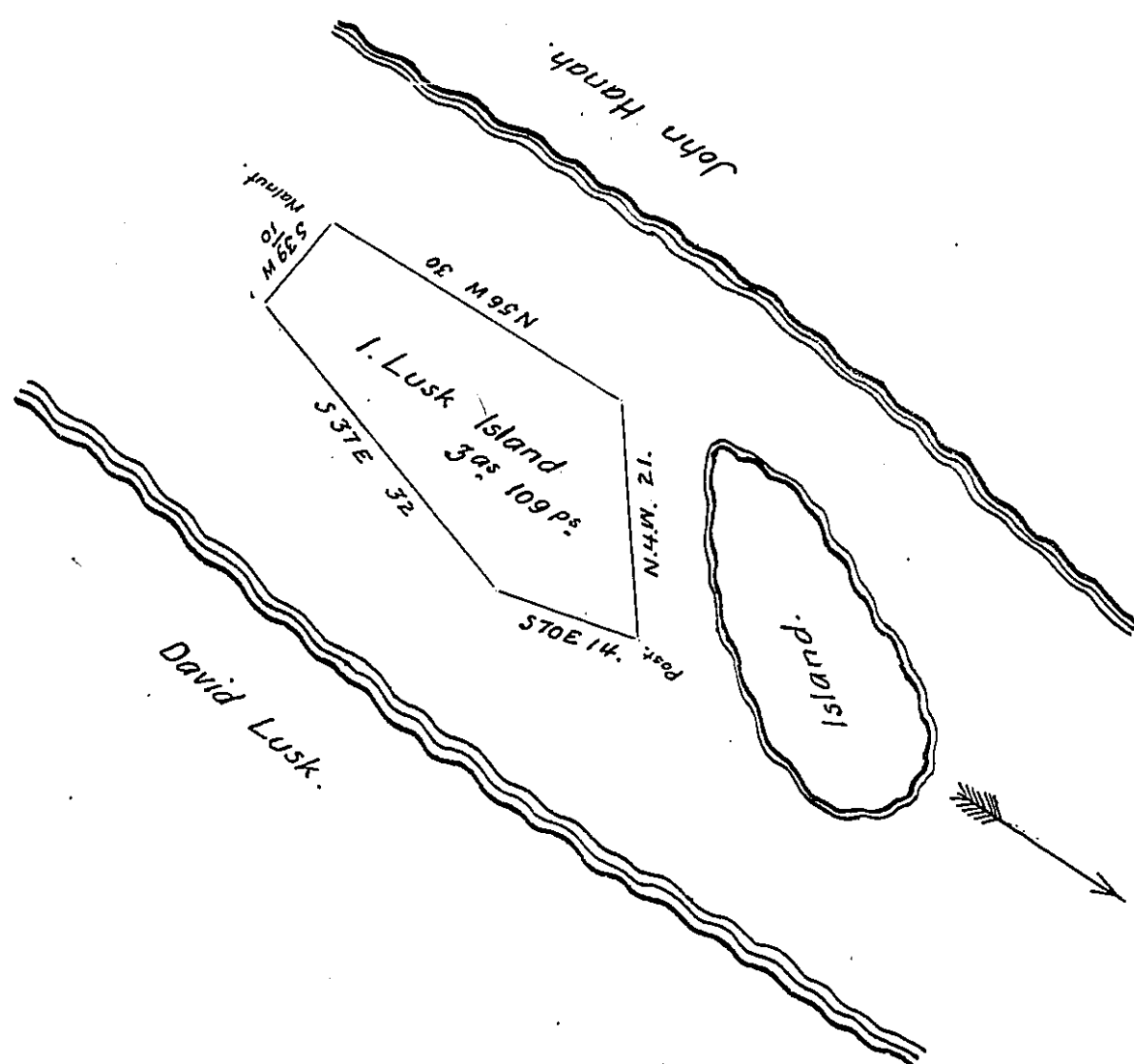


FORM NO. 1.



Surveyed the above described Island on the 24th day June 1815. in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Isaac Lusk dated the 3rd day of June 1815. Containing three Acres & one hundred & Nine perches strict measure. Situate near the middle of the West Branch of the Susquehanna. about two and half miles above the upper end of the Great Island, and immediately above Lusks lower Island. The farm of David Lusk on the South in Bald Eagle Township, & the Farm of John Hannah on the North in Dustable Township Lycoming County. Known by the name of Lusk or Hannahs Island. Unimproved.
