

Survey'd on the 27<sup>th</sup> of August 1812 for Robert Mellin in pursuance of his warrant dated the  
20<sup>th</sup> of April 1812 Containing Four hundred and thirteen Acres Nineteen perches and all  
allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c. including an improvement made by said Mellin.

The improvements on the tract are a square - log house with a family residing therein  
& about twenty Acres of cleared-land
