

The Draught of a tract of land Situate in Haines Township Centre County Containing two hundred and forty nine Acres forty eight perches and Allowance of six perCent for roads &c. Surveyed the seventh day of September 1813. In pursuance of a warrant granted to Philip Nies dated the 12th day of March 1812.

The above Survey includes an improvement made in April 1805, Consisting of a Cabbin House and Barn, about seven or eight Acres of Cleared Land and a few peach Trees planted, now occupied by Martin Craiger & family Tennant to the said Philip Nies.
