


FORM NO. 1.

allowance of 6 per cent.

Samuel Hoyt by virtue of his warrant dated the 8<sup>th</sup> day of December 1837 supposed  
to have been surveyed in the month of December 1837 by the Deputy Surveyor of  
Luzerne County

The above are true meridian courses - Variation 4° West.
