

of York containing as above set forth 19 as 10 pres. - and allowances &c which is part
of a larger tract of 97 as 139 pres. and allowances &c called Trout Prusa Originally
Surveyed on the 1st day of the 6th Mo. 1775 in Pursuance of two Warrants one dated
the 4th day of April 1751 for 50 as the other for 40 as dated the 9th day of October
1750, both granted to Philip Low.

Now on the 14th day of December A.D. 1839 having examined the above
and found to be correct, which had been resurveyed by John Becker late D.S. on the
4th day of August A.D. 1830 and being requested to make return of the same for William
Heathcote the present owner &c. who wishes to Patent the same.
