

Situate in Manahan Township in the County of York containing as above set forth 48^a & 80 Perches and the Usual Allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed on the 22^d day of November A.D. 1814 In Pursuance of a Warrant for 50^a granted to Daniel Williams bearing date the 2^d day of February A.D. 1804 Resurveyed on the 23^d day of August 1815 agreeably to the decision of the Honourable Board of Property dated the 7th day of June A.D. 1815 And now at the request of the owner Daniel Williams the above has been returned agreeably to the judgment and determination of arbitrators under a Rule of Court on a trial of an Ejectment Daniel Williams vs. David Ayres dated September 10th A.D. 1816
