



Situated in Hamilton Barn Township Adams County and Surveyed May - 1799

In pursuance of a Warrant for 80^a granted to William Waugh dated January 15th 1785

On the afores'd warrant Wm Waugh claimed a parcel of land which was also claimed by Joseph Brown under a warrant for 250^a granted him dated 17th April 1786 - I transmitted the claims of both parties by actual survey to the General Surveyor and on a hearing before the board a Judgment issued in favour of Joseph Brown. Wm Waugh commenced a suit in the Supreme Court and obtained a verdict in his favour on which Brown renewed the suit but the parties at last settled the dispute as in the above draught.
