

George Boyd dec'dLand for the use of the Poor at
Salisbury Township

The above draught describes the Land which Thomas Lightfoot D.S.
by Virtue of an Application No. 692 dated August 30th 1765 surveyed to
Andrew Burnside soon afterwards for 30 acres & allowance situate in West
Calm Township in the County of Chester and resurveyed the 5th day of March
1801 containing thirty two Acres & allowance of six P. Ct. for Roads &c. — The
above resurvey sign'd Charles Dilworth D.S. was put into my hands since
his decease in Order for return & having examined the same, am of Opinion
it may be depended upon.
