

Draft of a tract of land situate in Sugarcreek township Venango County ad-  
joining on French Creek on the north side and West of the Allegheny River Containing  
four hundred forty-five acres & allowance. Surveyed September 1st 1842 for the heirs  
of Ebenezer Roberts & Oliver Ormsby in pursuance of a warrant granted to the said  
Ebenezer Roberts and Oliver Ormsby dated 27<sup>th</sup> October 1806.

N.B. The dotted line shows the west boundary of the survey made on a war-  
rant in the name of Jas. Mead and east of said line is claimed by the heirs of David  
Mead.

Book of William Connely Esq. formerly Deputy Surveyor of Venango County I have
