


Charles O. Harra

The land contained in the above survey has been cleared a great many years ago comes very near the dwelling house of said Mathew Campbell and a stable stands on the said land &c I further beg leave to report that at the time of surveying the said land said Mathew Campbell, said he claimed all the land contained in the above survey in right of said Henry Robinson
