

Isaac Taylor's Land Situate on a branch of Oct<u>araroe</u> Creek in the Town-Ship of Sadbury in the County of Chester part of one Thousand acres granted to him by the Comiss se Warr's dated the 23d day of March 1713/4.

Begins at a corner marked chesnut Tree being a corner of Caleb Pusey's Land thence South by the said Pusey's Land 180 peches to a post thence west by Vacant Land 283 peches to a Hickery thence North by Vacant Land 180 peches to a post thence East by Vacant Land 283 peches to the place of 8equining Containing three Hundred acres, and the Allowance of Six acres pechet.
