

## Donation Land in District N° 6—

Lot N° MCXXXIII.



In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania passed the 24<sup>th</sup> Day of February 1785 entitled "an Act for the directing the Mode of distributing the donation Lands, promised the Troops of this Commonwealth" and by order of the surveyor General with the Approval of the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Executive Council, I have surveyed on the 8<sup>th</sup> Day of November 1785 the above described Tract of Two hundred Acres & Allowance of six ~~sq C<sup>t</sup>~~ for Roads &c. N° 1133 — situate in District N° 6 on the West side of Allegany River in the County of Westmoreland
