

In pursuance of an act of Gen<sup>t</sup>l Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785 Intituled an act for Directing the mode of Distributing the Donation lands promised to the troops of this Commonwealth & by Order of the surveyor Gen<sup>t</sup>l with the Approbation of the Hon<sup>e</sup> Executive Council I have surveyed on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of Aug<sup>t</sup> 1785 the above described tract of two hundred Acres & Allow. of 6  $\frac{1}{2}$  Cent for Roads &c No MCCCLXXXVII situate in Dist No 7 on the west side of the Allegy River in the County of Westmorland
