

In pursuance of an act of General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785 Intitled an Act for Directing the Mode of Distributing the Donation Lands Promised to the troops of the Commonwealth & by Order of the Surveyor Gen<sup>r</sup>l with the approbation of the Hon<sup>e</sup> the Executive Council I have surveyed on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of July 1785 the above described tract of two Hundred Acres & Allow. of 6 of Cent for Roads &c. No MCCCLII situate in District No 7 on the West side of the Alegeny river in the County of Westmorland —
