 1785 the above described tract of two hundred acres of Land & Allow<sup>ce</sup>  
 of six ~~pp~~ Ct for Roads &c. No. DCCXXXVIII situate in District No 4 on  
 the west side of the Alleghany in the County of Westmoreland
