the State of Pennsylvania, passed the 24th day of Fe-
bruary 1785, entitled, "An Act for directing the mode of
distributing the Donation Lands promised the troops
by this Commonwealth;" and by order of the Sur-
veyor General, with the approbation of the honorable
the Executive Council, I have surveyed, on the 6th.
day of June 1786, the above described Tract of
Three hundred Acres of Land, and allowance for
roads &c. No 86, situate in District No. 1, on the west
side of the Alleghany river, in the county of Westmoreland.
