In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the  
State of Pennsylvania, passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of Febru-  
ary 1785, entitled, "An Act for directing the mode of  
distributing the donation lands Promised to the Troops  
of this Commonwealth" and by order of the Surveyor  
General with the approbation of the Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Supreme  
Executive Council, I have surveyed on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of  
October 1785, the above discribed Tract of Two Hun-  
dered acres of land and allowance of six  $\frac{7}{8}$  Cent for  
Roads &c. No. IX. situate in district No. 1, on the West-  
side of The Allegany river, in the County of Westmoreland.
