



In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania, passed the 24<sup>th</sup>. day of February 1785, entitled, "An Act for directing the mode of distributing the donation lands promised the Troops of this Commonwealth; and by order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Honourable the Supreme Executive Council, I have surveyed on the 29<sup>th</sup>. day of October 1785, the above described Tract of Two Hundred acres of Land, and allowance of six percent. for roads &c. N° XC1.— situate in District N° 1. on the west side of the Allegany river, in the county of Westmoreland.
