Patent to issue to Rachel Morris in trust for the
use of herself and the children of Abraham Morris
deceased. October 31st. 1795.

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State
of Pennsylvania, passed the 24th day of February 1785, en-
titled "An Act for directing the mode of distributing the do-
nation lands promised the Troops of this Commonwealth;
and by order of the Surveyor General with the approba-
tion of the Honourable the Supreme Executive Council,
I have surveyed on the 29th day of October 1785, the a-
bove described Tract of Two Hundred acres of land, and
allowance of six percent. for roads &c. No. LXXXIX. situ-
ate in District No. 1. on the west side of the Allegany river,
in the county of Westmoreland.
