 of the Honourable the Supreme Executive Council; I-  
 have surveyed on the 24<sup>th</sup>. day of October 1785, the above  
 described Tract of Two Hundred acres of Land, and al-  
 lowance of six per cent. for roads &c. No. LXXXV. situate  
 in District No. 1. on the west side of the Allegany river,  
 in the county of Westmoreland.
