


FORM NO 1.



Draft of a Tract of Land situate in Peters Township, Franklin County, Containing three hundred & four acres sixty one perches & allowance of six per cent for roads, &c. Surveyed the 22nd of August, 1829 (on an application granted James Ross for 300⁹⁵ of land joining James Dickey in Peters Township, dated the 30th of October, 1767, No. 4536). In pursuance of a contract with the Board of Property for carrying into effect the several Acts of Assembly relating to proprietary rights, &c.
