


FORM No 1.

For the Boundary in the Order see a Survey of Robert Sanderson Dated 1767



Draught of a tract of land situate in Toboyne Township, Perry County, Containing one hundred fifty nine Acres 108  $\frac{1}{2}$  & allowance of six per Cent for roads, &c. Surveyed May the 15<sup>th</sup> 1832, in pursuance of an Order granted Robert Adams dated October 22<sup>nd</sup>, 1767, No<sup>o</sup> 4517.

No. 2. Contains 49  $\frac{1}{2}$  131  $\frac{1}{2}$  & allowance. Surveyed on a Warrant to W<sup>th</sup> Anderson, dated May 6<sup>th</sup>, 1793. All of which is now owned by James Johnston & John Johnston.
