

In pursuance of An act of Gen^tl Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania ^{is} passed the 24th day of February 1785 - Intituled an act for Directing the mode of Distributing the Donation Lands promised to the troops of this Commonwealth & by order of the Surveyor Gen^tl With the Approbation of the Hon^t Executive Council I have surveyed on the 29th day of Augt 1785 the Above Described tract of two Hundred Acres & Allow of 6 PCent for Roads &c. N^o MCCCCXXXIV situate in Dist N^o 7 on the West side of the Allegeny River in the County of Westmorland -
