

In pursuance of an act of Gen^tl Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania ^{n^o 111 passed the 24th day of February 1785 intitled an act for Directing the mode of Described, ~~tract & x~~ the Donation Lands promised to the troops of this Commonwealth & by order of the Surveyor Gen^tl With the Approbation of the Hon^t the Executive Council I have surveyed on the 7th day of Sept^r 1785 the Above Described tract of two Hundred Acres & Allow of 6 Pcent for Roads &c N^o M.D.XII situate in District N^o 7 on the west side of the Alleg^y River in the County of Westmoreland.}
