



In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly
of the state of Pennsylvania, passed the 24th day of February, 1785,
entitled "An Act for directing the mode of distributing the Donation
Lands promised the Troops of this Commonwealth"; and by order of
the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Honourable the Supreme
Executive Council, I have surveyed on the 18th day of November 1785, the
above described Tract of two hundred and fifty acres of land, and
allowance of six per cent for roads, &c. No. 153 situate in District
No. 8. on the west side of the Allegany river, in the county of West-
moreland.
