

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly
of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the 24th day of February, 1785,
entitled "An Act for directing the mode of distributing the Donation
Land, granted by the Legislature of this Commonwealth"; and by order
of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Honourable the
Supreme Executive Council, I have surveyed on the 26th day of
October, 1785, the above described Tract of two Hundred Acres of
Land, at an allowance of six per cent. for roads, &c. No. 1736 situate
in District No. 8. on the West side of the Allegany river, in the
County of Armstrong.
