

IN PURSUANCE OF AN ACT OF GENERAL ASSEMBLY  
OF THE STATE OF PENNSYLVANIA PASSED THE 27 DAY OF FEBRUARY 1785  
ENTITLED, "AN ACT FOR DIRECTING THE MODE OF DISTRIBUTING THE DONATION  
LANDS PROMISED TO THE TROOPS OF THIS COMMONWEALTH." AND BY ORDER  
OF THE SURVEYOR GENERAL WITH THE APPROBATION OF THE HON<sup>ble</sup> EXECUTIVE  
COUNCIL I HAVE SURVEYED ON THE 18 OF JULY 1785 THE ABOVE DESCRIBED  
TRACT OF TWO HUNDRED ACRES AND ALLOWANCE OF SIX PCT FOR ROADS  
SC. N<sup>o</sup> M.D.C.C.C.LXX SITUATE IN DISTRICT N<sup>o</sup>. 10 ON THE WEST SIDE OF  
ALLEGHENY RIVER IN THE COUNTY OF WESTMORELAND.
