


Hazard Land Dist No 5

In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Penn<sup>a</sup>  
passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785 entitled. "An Act for directing  
the Mode of distributing the Donation Land promised the Troops  
of this Commonwealth" and by order of the Surveyor General  
with the approbation of the Hon'ble Executive Council - I have  
Survey'd on the 21<sup>st</sup> Day of September 1785. the above described  
Tract of two hundred Acres of Land and Allowance of six  
p Cent for roads &c N<sup>o</sup> DCCCLVIII Situate in District N<sup>o</sup> 4  
on the West Side of the Alligany River in the County of  
Westmoreland
