

In pursuance of an act of Gen^t Assembly of the State of Pennsy^a, passed the 24th day of February, 1785: intitled, An Act for Directing the mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised to the Troops of this Commonwealth & by order of the Surveyor Gen^t with the approbation of the Hon^t Executive Council, I have Surveyed on the 24th day of Augt. 1785. the above described tract of Two Hundred acres, & Allow of 6 p Cent for Roads, &c, No MCCCXIV. Situate in in Dist No. 7. on the West Side of the Alleg^y River in Westmorland County.
