

In pursuance of an act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the 24th day of February, 1785, Intituled an Act for Directing the mode of Distributing the Donation Lands Promised to the Troops of this Commonwealth, & by order of the Surveyor General — With the Approbation of the Hon' the Executive Council, I have Surveyed on the 8th day July, 1785, the above described tract of two hundred Acres & Allow^{ce} of 6 per cent for roads &c No M.O.O.CXXII Situate in District No. 7. on the west side of the Allegeny River in the County of Westmoreland.
