


Lot No 1400.

Intituled an Act of Distributing the Donation Lands, promised to the Thoo^{ps} of this Commonwealth & by order of the Surveyor General — With the Approbation of the Hon' the Executive Council I have Surveyed on the 9th day of Augt. 1785, the above described — tract of Two Hundred Acres & Allow: of 6 per cent for roads &c No MCCCCI, Situate in District No 7. on the West Side of the Alleg^y River in the County of Westmorland.
