

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the 24th day of February, 1785, entitled An Act for directing the mode of distributing the Donation Lands, promised the Troops of this Commonwealth, and by order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Honble the Executive Council, I have Surveyed on the 7th day of October, 1785, the above described tract of Three Hundred Acres & allowance of Six p Cent, for roads &c, No XLVIII. Situate in District N^o. 5. on the West side of the Allegany River in the County of Westmoreland.
