

In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the

State of Pennsylvania, passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1785. —  
 entitled, "An Act for directing the Mode of distributing the Donation  
 Lands promised to the Troops of this Commonwealth, And by Order  
 of the Surveyor General with <sup>the</sup> Approbation of the Honble Execu-  
 tive Council, I have Surveyed on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1785,  
 the above described Tract of three hundred acres and allowance  
 of Six per cent for roads &c. No XCVI, Situate in district No. 10,  
 on the West Side of Alleghany River in the County of Westmoreland,
