


Lot N 480



In Pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of
 the State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty fourth Day of February,
 One thousand seven hundred and eighty five, entitled an Act "for direc-
 ting the Mode of distributing the Donation Lands, promised to the
 Troops by this Commonwealth," and by Order of the Surveyor General,
 with the Approbation of the Honorable the Executive Council, I have
 Surveyed on the first Day of October One thousand Seven hundred
 and eighty five, the above described Tract of Two hundred Acres of
 Land, and Allowance for Roads, &c. No. 479. Situate in District No.
 III, on the West Side of the Alleghany, in the County of Westmoreland.
