

Lands promised the Troops of this "Commonwealth" and by order

Executive Council, I have Survey'd on the 19th Day of September
1785- the above described Tract of two hundred Acres of Land
and allowance of six PC^t for roads &c No DCCCXLIX, Situate in
District No 4 on the West Side of the Allegany river in the
County of Westmoreland.
