



Situate in Buffaloe township Union (late Berks) County Surveyed the 1<sup>st</sup>. day of May A.D. 1833 by virtue of an Order No 3361 Granted to Mary Allen dated the 3<sup>d</sup>. day of April 1769 containing two hundred & seventy one acres with the usual allowance of six per cent. &c.

The same was Surveyed the 22<sup>d</sup>. day of March A. Dom.  
1770 for George Palmer by virtue of his order No 422 da-  
ted the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April A.D. 1769 now owned & occupied  
by Isaac Eyer in right of the said George Palmer.
