



Situate in Turbut Township North^d. County near the mouth of Delaware run including an old Indian Fort & adjoining Edward Middleton at the Turkey bottom, surveyed the 3rd day of October 1835 by virtue of an Order dated the 3rd day of April 1769 No 2364 granted to Matthew Grimes containing two hundred and sixty three acres & ten perches & the usual allowance of six per cent. &c.

Note - The same is a part of a larger tract of land which was surveyed the 23rd day of May 1769 for Capt. William Piper in pursuance of his Order dated the 4th day of February 1769, and is now owned and occupied by Christian Gork in right of said Capt. Wm. Piper.

P. S. the above survey to include the old Indian Fort, could not include the mouth of Delaware run, it is near the mouth of said run as could be placed.
