



Situate in Turbut Township Northumberland County, on a stream leading into the N. Easterly side of the west branch of the Susquehanna, beginning at a fallen W. O. said to have been marked Z.F. which once stood on the bank of said stream.

Surveyed on the 23rd day of October 1835 by virtue of an order dated the 3rd day of April 1769. No 1575 granted to William Dillwyn, containing three hundred and twelve acres & one hundred & seventeen perches & the usual allowance of six per cent &c.

Note The same tract of land was surveyed for Robert Norris on the day of 17- by virtue of his order dated the 14th day of June 1769. No. 3492 and is now owned and occupied by Peter Mangas S. Glaz & others in right of said Robert Norris.
