

Situate in White Deer township, Union County. Surveyed the 10th. day of September AD. 1832, By virtue of an order dated 3d day of April 1769.

No. 1565 granted to Elizabeth Mc Caskrey. Containing three hundred acres with the usual allowance of Six per cent &c.

Note. the above tract is parts of two tracts of land which was Surveyed to John Zimmerman & Deterich Rees the 22 & 23d days of October 1769 in pursuance of their orders viz. Zimmerman and No. 14 & Rees No.— and now owned & occupied by Jacob McCurley, John Hoffman and others.
