



Situate in Buffalo township Union [late Berks] County Surveyed the 4th day of May 1833 by Virtue of an Order granted to ^{Joseph} ~~Jacob~~ Glenn dated the 3d. day of April, 1769. No. 1385. Containing One Hundred and Sixty eight Acres with the usual allowance of Six pr. Cent &c.

The same tract of land was Surveyed the 12th day of August 1769 for Thomas Lowry in pursuance of his Order dated the 3d. day of April, 1769. No. 266. Now held by the heirs of James Jenkins in right of Thomas Lowry. Jno Hayes Con.
